CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the Eleven to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This mystery of one God composed of three persons is central to our faith. How are we to evangelize this absurd sounding mystery to everyone as Jesus commissioned? Perhaps we can look to the words attributed to St. Francis: "Preach the Gospel always; use words if necessary." In our actions, we can embody the triune mystery of creative, redeeming, and life-giving love. By creatively seeking solutions to injustice, loving those around us as they are, and giving of ourselves for the good of others, we are living out Christ's command.

PARISH TRUSTEE NOMINATION

FORMATION

Every parish in the State of Wisconsin, besides being a faith Community, is also a legal corporation of Wisconsin. As such, it is subject to state corporation law, which means (among other things) it must have five trustees. The archbishop and the vicar general of the archdiocese are ex-officio trustees in every parish of the archdiocese. The pastor/parish director of the parish is the third exofficio trustee. The parish also has a trustee-treasurer and a trustee-secretary.

The term of our Trustee-Treasurer, Rebecca Porter, expires on June 30, 2024. Rebecca is willing to serve another term.

The pastor/parish director may nominate one candidate for the position. Accordingly, Deb has nominated Rebecca Porter for the position of trustee-treasurer. Should anyone else desire nomination for this role, state law dictates that we follow this process: such a person must be an actual member of the parish, at least 25 years of age, and must receive the written support of at least 10 other adult parishioners. Nominations should be submitted to the parish office with the accompanying names and signatures of supporters no later than May 29, 2024. Please contact the Parish Office if you have any questions about this process.

According to state law, this notice will be published here for four weeks. Should there be other nominee(s), biographical information will be available the weekend of June 1-2 with an election held the weekend of June 8-9.


