# **NOTES FROM DEB**

## **Saturday Mass Time**

As a pastoral staff, we continue to look for ways to better serve our community. We do this for all our ministries—in everything from how we incorporate baptisms into the Mass, to funeral planning, to the timing of our Masses.

In response to parishioner requests, and after much prayer and discernment, the Pastoral Staff has decided to move up the time for our Saturday evening Mass.

Beginning on September 7, 2024, our Saturday Mass will be at 4:00 pm.

The days are long and lovely at this time of year, but the autumn days are short. More than a few folks in the parish have concerns about driving at night. The earlier Mass time will make the Saturday Mass easier to attend for those members of our parish family.

Another concern this change addresses centers around families with young children. We are hoping that the 4:00 pm Mass time will make the Saturday liturgy an option for more families. When my kids were young, we never attended this liturgy because it was too early for supper before Mass, and by the time we got home afterward, it was too late to begin cooking. This earlier Mass time also coincides with what other parishes in the area are doing.

I know that change is not always easy—especially when it comes to something as important to us as the time we come to Mass. It is my hope that once we adjust our routines, the 4:00 pm Mass will be a positive, wonderful change for our parish community.

As always, please know that I welcome your suggestions to further our mission as a loving parish community.

# **SPOTLIGHT**

## **Unsung Disciples - The Sacristans**

According to Donna Van Wynsberghe, sacristans are the dedicated "behind the scenes" folks who prepare the items needed for each liturgy. They are responsible for setting out the cups, bowls for hosts, and purificators for wiping the wine cups. The hosts and wine for the Offertory procession must be prepared as well. Sacristans also light the candles, greet the presiding priest, and ensure that all their needs are met. After each liturgy, the cups are purified in a three-step process and put away in readiness for the next liturgy. Hosts are returned to the tabernacle and the candles are extinguished.

At present, there are six or seven sacristans who serve all three weekend liturgies as well as the Wednesday morning liturgy. How wonderful it would be if we could increase that number and ease the rotation schedule!

## Are you ready to get involved?




