Follow-up - Quarterly Finance Presentation

After our last quarterly finance presentation some questions arose about the difference between our online donation options WeShare and ACH transfers.

WeShare is one option for donating to our operating fund or improvement fund, and you can also choose other funds such as St. Vincent de Paul, St. Ben's, the Food Pantry, Haiti, and memorials. You can even pay registration fees for our programs such as GIFT. This handy flexibility comes with a cost—WeShare deducts a portion of your gift (3.75%) to pay for the service; however, you can opt to pay this fee so your whole gift goes to OLOL.

The other online giving option is an ACH transfer. This service transfers money from your bank account to either our general operating fund or our improvement fund only on the 1st or 16th of the month. This service is free and administered by the Parish Office, but it does not have the same flexibility as WeShare. If you have questions about or need assistance with either of these options, please call the parish director of administrative services.

Feel free to use whichever service meets your needs, and please know of my gratitude for your sustained stewardship of the parish. It takes no small amount of funds to keep all our ministries going. Your faithful generosity helps us to continue to build God's kin-dom through our prayer and outreach to our neighbors near and far.



Capuchin Community Services Special Appeal (St. Ben's Meal Program)
