Parking Lot Resurfacing!

I don't have to tell anyone who parks in the south parking lot of the building that the lot is in dire need of resurfacing. Using some of the Love One Another funds, our south parking lot will be resurfaced beginning on Monday, July 22 (weather permitting). That parking lot will be closed from Monday, July 22, through Friday, July 26. There will be no access to a parking lot from either 57th Street or 58th Street this week. Street parking will be available on 58th Street, and our east parking lot will remain open throughout the week.

The only way to access our east parking lot will be from 56th Street.

There is a two-way driveway that leads to our facility less than 1/10 of a mile from Forest Home Avenue on the west side of 56th Street. If you have any questions about this, please contact the Parish Office and we will be happy to assist you.

It is our hope that all entrances to our parking lots will be open before our Masses next weekend.

Thank you again for your financial generosity to the parish and especially to the Love One Another campaign. This improvement will make driving over the lot easier, and it will also make walking across the lot so much safer.



FORMATION

Baptism at Lourdes



Prepare for buying tickets

- State law requires 1 name per ticket, complete address and phone number.
- Consider tucking mailing labels in your pocket or purse. Then all you have to add is your phone number.
- Law also requires that tickets not be folded or bent.

Sales
