Politics

Whew... When the subject of politics comes up these days, I find myself in need of taking a deep breath.

This is the summer of political conventions, streams of political ads, and most frighteningly, political violence. And as much as we might want to divorce ourselves from the political issues swirling around us, as faithful Catholic Christians, that is not an option. In its statement *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship*, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops state, "In the Catholic Tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation" (No. 13).

We have a moral obligation to evaluate the many significant issues of this election cycle and to see how they conform to our consciences and the teachings of the Church. Issues like immigration, healthcare, care for the poor, the sacredness of all life, and the structure of our democratic republic are all on the table this year. These serious issues demand our prayerful attention.

We are morally obligated to participate in civic life, but we are not obligated to let ourselves be overwhelmed by politics. We are not obligated to consume political news hour upon hour or "doom scroll" through social media. Nor are we obligated to engage in every political discussion that comes our way.

Let's all practice some good self-care these days, and let's be respectful of one another – even those with whom we disagree.


GIFT Sign-Up is Open
