

In the Gospel, the crowd asks Jesus, "What sign can you do, that we may see and believe in you?" Are we still asking that question? How do you work to deeply believe?



The OLOL social justice committee urges all disciples to vote in the Wisconsin Partisan Primary on Tuesday, August 13. On the Congressional Level, ballots will list candidates for U.S. Senate and Representatives in Congress. On the Legislative and State Level, ballots will list candidates



for the Assembly, and District Attorney. County races will include county clerk, treasurer, and registrar of deeds.

In addition, on the back of the ballot, there will be two important referendums regarding the elimination of checks and balances in distributing federal funds. To obtain explanations regarding these proposals, search "referendums on Wisconsin ballot."
