CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING

Sometimes the behavior of the disciples in the Gospels is cringe-worthy. In today's Gospel reading from Mark, Jesus hears his disciples arguing about who is the greatest. He explains that to be the greatest, one must put themselves last and behave as a servant, accepting the least among them.

We cringe when we recognize an undesirable behavior, yet often we are guilty of similar behavior. It is human nature to raise oneself up; to try to achieve an edge above others. Yet, our dignity doesn't come from our achievements. Our human dignity is inherent. Our value is the same if we have wealth and accolades as it is if we are poor and devalued. Jesus challenges us to discard the notion that status increases our worth.
