Committee Reports:

• **Octoberfest:** Barb reported on the current status of Octoberfest:

OLOL is celebrating the 15th year anniversary of Oktoberfest Artisan Fair. In addition to meeting its goals of building relationships within the community, sharing joy with visitors, providing a respectful market place for local artists of diverse cultures, and harvesting the talents of parishioners, Oktoberfest has also brought in an estimated \$133,000 since inception. Relationship building continues to drive all decisions and making money is a secondary benefit.

- o Currently we have approximately 23 artist vendors.
- We request prayers for many more volunteers and have highlighted essential spots for serving food.
- Publicity includes yard signs, electronic presence, local publications, submission to area church bulletins, and much more. Many thanks to St. Greg's and St. Matthias for displaying yard signs.
- The winner portion for 50/50 is over \$725 to date.
- Meetings began in January. Last team planning meeting is 9/25/2024.
- Youth Representative Report: The first confirmation class was held and it was very good.
- Social Justice: A prayer service is scheduled for November 4 at 6:30 to pray for Peace and Good Leadership, in anticipation of the election; the Social Justice committee is also in the early stages of planning a joint Mass with All Saints
- **Liturgy:** Lazarus Service of Remembrance will be held Monday, November 18. Our Thanksgiving Mass will include a bread exchange
- **Finance Council**: Rebecca Porter shared that financially, we are on track, and budget is going well.
- **Discipleship Institute**: The Chosen is running and the rest of the schedule can be found online.
